9. TRAFFIC GROUP – Clir Mason

• HIP – Cllr Booth. Update

Cllr Booth & Cllr Sweetland met with Ian Grigor, Kent Highways Schemes Manager on the 2nd November to discuss the Highways Improvement Plan.

A number of items were identified for review and once completed IG Kent Highways will be producing a revised HIP.

Speeding Traffic.

CPC have requested that the whole parish become a 30mph per hour zone with specific areas, 20mph – to include The Street, Round Street to Gold Street, & Green Lands to Station Approach.

IG agreed to review against current traffic data.

Battle Street to Sole Street

CPC have identified this area a speeding hot spot.

IG has agreed to review and investigate traffic calming measures – CPC / Mat Mason should supply SID data to IG.

HGV Traffic – The Street. Currently "7.5 tonne except for access"

IG agreed to review the current TRO and possibly introduce "7.5 tonne ONLY" with specific exceptions for local businesses.

Sole Street – Round Street to Gold Street and Scrattons Field.

CPC have identified this stretch of road as the most dangerous in the parish.

IG has agreed to ask the KCC Bus Stop team to investigate establishing a permanent bus stop at the corner of Round Street & Sole Street.

IG agreed to cost a Feasibility Study for traffic management, to include a footway. CPC indicated that they might be able to fund the cost of the study and have identified this project for help from the LTC Legacy Fund.

CPC / Mat Mason should supply SID data to IG and Bella Gabbitas the detailed report from the parishioner who was knocked over in this area.

War Memorial Roundabout.

CPC have identified this area as an accident black spot and have requested protective bollards along the boundary fence line of Pilgrims.

This is land owned by KCC and IG agreed to design and cost – CPC indicated that they might be able to fund the cost.

DYL / Parking Restrictions -The Street

The outcome of the consultation was that KCC had 3 objections, and decided that as there are plans and designs ongoing; where the lines currently covered by an experimental order may not be needed, the order will run as it currently stands. At the end of the experimental order, or when the designs are completed by Chris Koningen; then the permanent order will be reviewed.

IG agreed to extend the hatching outside the school and field - to be extended to the Ship Inn *Village Gateways Features – Halfpence Lane*

New design to be approved – Cost £4,968

The Street – Traffic Calming

KCC Highways are proposing to build out both sides of The Street replacing the existing bollards to create genuine single file traffic, with priority give-way at either end.

Cobblestones – detail of previous supplier

Darnley Arms.

A new stick down kerb and sign has been installed outside the pub.

This is a temporary measure installed by Kent Highways until the main scheme calming measures are installed in February 2022.
